



Mariners Centre MHL Visiting Team Protocols



MHL Visitor Team:

PLEASE REVIEW ALL ice usage policies thoroughly before arriving at the Mariners Center to ensure all rules are understood by all those entering the facility. **A Health & Safety representative must be appointed by all user groups to ensure the following policies are adhered to:**

The Mariners Center will follow and enforce all guidelines determined by our Provincial Government and Public Health.

CONTACT TRACING: On or in advance of Game Day VISITING TEAM must submit list of players, coaching staff, bus driver and team personnel who will be entering the facility with full contact tracing detail. The visiting team must keep their own health screening and contact tracing records for a period of 21 days.

PHYSICAL DISTANCING: While on the premises of the Mariners Centre (including parking lot, all common areas, dressing rooms, staging areas) physical distancing of 6 feet must be maintained between patrons, spectators, players, coaches, officials and employees.

ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE: The visiting team can arrive no earlier than 2 hours before game time and depart no later than 45 minutes after game time. Everyone must sanitize prior to entering the facility.

ENTRY and EXIT: Visiting Team and supporting personnel are to ENTER through the Main Lobby into designated Arena 1 Change Rooms and EXIT through the Emergency Exit at the end of Arena 1 Change Room hallway. Facility common areas will be for through traffic only – no loitering/socializing is permitted at this time.

MASKS: Masks must be worn by all players/coaches/staff at all times (except while on the ice), including during team warm-up.

WARM UP: Using an example of a 7:30PM game, the Visiting Team warm up must take place between 6:20PM and 6:40 PM to allow the prior Guest User Group the opportunity to exit and be available again for Junior A Spectators arrival. Visiting Team warm-up area is limited to upper concourse only above Arena 1 Change Rooms. Absolutely no balls/pucks/sticks on upper concourse.

FIELD OF PLAY: Other than the brief warm-up in the upper concourse, Field of Play requirements are to be followed with limits of 50 total participants at ice level (Including Benches, Dressing Room hallway and Dressing Rooms). Two dressing rooms will be assigned for the visiting team with access to showers. Players/Coaches/Staff are not permitted in the stands or any area associated with the Three Zones dedicated to Spectators.

VISITING NON-DRESSED PLAYERS & SUPPORT STAFF: Non-Dressed Players and Support Staff (e.g.; Bus Driver) will have a designated bubble of seats assigned, however once they sit down and leave the field of play they are not permitted back into the Field of Play (e.g.; dressing room area) until the end of the game.

VISITING FANS: Tickets are available through Skybox Rentals (Bubbles of Ten). Skybox rental fee is \$60 (incl. tax) plus regular price for spectator tickets to the game. Skyboxes and Tickets can be purchased by calling our box office at (902) 742-2155
