



## Mariners Centre - Facility Specific Protocols

### TWO Zone Plan @ 100 Spectators Per Zone

#### Spectator Fundamentals:

- Seats are organized into three separated zones of approximately 200 Seats
  - **Zone 1 (sections 1-3)** will enter/exit through the main Entrance and exit through upper concourse stairwell. Dedicated washrooms are in upper lobby.
  - **Zone 2 (sections 4-7)** will enter/exit through the West End Stairs with dedicated washrooms on West Concourse
- Wheelchair accessible seats are available in Zone 1
- Health Screening & Contact tracing must be captured in advance and/or at the gate
- Doors open 30 minutes before game time and all participants and spectators must exit within 20 minutes of conclusion of game
- Masks are to be worn at all times inside the Mariners Centre except when consuming food or beverage
- No standing room on concourse or at rink-side
- Spectators will be able to enter & exit at intermission if necessary
- Arena 2 and certain areas of Arena 1 will not be accessible to spectators

<b>Zones of 100 Spectators</b>	<p><b>Attendance:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• A maximum of 100 tickets/attendees will be permitted into each Zone,</li> <li>• Spectator expectations around access (entrance/exit), and COVID requirements (including Masks and Social Distancing) are communicated to all attendees in advance/and or at gate</li> </ul> <p><b>Entry/Exit:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Access to the facility will be granted up to the limit of 100 spectators per zone</li> <li>• Each Zone will have a dedicated Entry/Exit point</li> <li>• Ticket takers and ushers will be dedicated to each Zone to ensure spectators take their seats and avoid congestion during intermissions and exit following the game.</li> <li>• Spectators are permitted to enter &amp; exit the facility through their dedicated entrance at intermission if necessary</li> </ul> <p><b>Separation:</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Each Zone will have its own Entry/Exit, washrooms and concession and will be physically separated by pipe and drape barriers and caution tape.           <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Dedicated washrooms clearly communicated in advance and through Ushers, Game announcements and Facility Signage</li> </ul> </li> <li>• Volunteer ushers will monitor and enforce social distancing and mask requirements within the stands</li> <li>• Social distancing between individual attendees will be required at all times allowing same household or known social groupings of up to 10 persons.</li> </ul>

<p><b>Patron Declarations</b></p>	<p>All spectators will answer the following questions (declarations) before entry:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Is the person feeling unwell?</li> <li>• Have they traveled outside Atlantic Canada within the last 14 days?</li> <li>• Are they a close contact of a confirmed case of COVID-19?</li> <li>• Are they waiting for results of a COVID-19 test?</li> <li>• Are you self-isolating for any reason?</li> </ul>
<p><b>Food &amp; Beverage</b></p>	<p>Any food or canteen service will be Zone Specific. At the writing of this document we will have a basic set-up of non-alcoholic beverages and snacks. Plexiglass will physically separate staff and floor markings will guide a socially distant line-up. Sanitization will take place between the handling of any money and food or beverage.</p>
