



## Mariners Centre – Meeting Room Protocols

As a public venue, the Mariners Centre is required to follow the Health Protection Act and public health directives to limit the spread of COVID-19. To support clarity of our Facility Specific Requirements, this document is to serve as a resource for both Guest User Groups and Individuals.

Mariners Centre staff are committed to working closely with all guests and user groups to ensure clear communication of facility protocols to support safe events and activity for all.

### Meeting Room Protocols:

- **Hand Sanitizer** will be available at both the lobby entrance and at entry of meeting room
- **Masks** are to be worn at all times inside the Mariners Centre
  - Exceptions for meeting room guests include when sitting down at your seat, socially distanced from the next closest guest
  - Masks may also be taken off to consume food and drink while ensuring proper social distance (6 feet) from those around you
  - In-Person Presenter and Facilitators who cannot maintain a safe distance from their audience must wear a mask when presenting in our meeting rooms
  - If attendees do not have a Mask, Mariners Centre Staff will provide one
- **Social Distancing (6 feet)** is required of all attendees when in the Mariners Centre, except when seated in the programmed meeting space ensuring proper social distance (6 feet) from those around you.
- **Health Screening & Contact tracing** must be captured in advance of the meeting and/or entry for all attendees, organizers and facilitators
- **Meeting Room Set-Up** will adhere to the NS Public Health Guidelines for COVID-19, ensuring social distance of attendees based on your required guests and our room capacity
- Meeting Organizers should advise all attendees of **NS Public Health guidelines** before arrival to ensure everyone's awareness and safety
- Nova Scotia Public Health **COVID-19 restrictions may change**, requiring our facility protocols to be updated to ensure guidelines are met
- If COVID-19 restrictions and/or our Facility Protocols are not followed by meeting organizers the Mariners Centre will stop the meeting to ensure compliance or cancel meeting in the interest of attendee safety
