



## Mariners Centre Minor Hockey & Highschool Hockey - Visiting Team Protocols



### Visitor Team:

PLEASE REVIEW ALL existing facility protocols thoroughly before arriving at the Mariners Center to ensure all rules are understood by all those entering the facility. This document is meant to compliment our more thorough Facility Protocols document. **A Health & Safety representative must be appointed by all user groups to ensure the following policies are adhered to:**

The Mariners Center will follow and enforce all guidelines determined by our Provincial Government and Public Health.

**MASKS:** Masks are mandatory and must be worn by all players/coaches/staff at all times (except while on the ice). Zero tolerance for non-compliance.

**CONTACT TRACING:** On or in advance of Game Day VISITING TEAM must submit list of players, coaching staff, bus driver and team personnel who will be entering the facility with full contact tracing detail. The visiting team must keep their own health screening and contact tracing records for a period of 21 days.

**PHYSICAL DISTANCING:** While on the premises of the Mariners Centre (including parking lot, all common areas, dressing rooms, staging areas) physical distancing of 6 feet must be maintained between patrons, spectators, players, coaches, officials and employees.

**ARRIVAL and DEPARTURE:** VISITING TEAM can arrive no earlier than 20 minutes before game time and depart no later than 20 minutes after game time. Everyone must sanitize prior to entering the facility. PARENTS & SPECTATORS must remain outside (in their vehicles) until 5 minutes before game start. If games are running late, the team safety rep will communicate when they may enter.

### **ENTRY and EXIT (see page 2 visual):**

Main Entrance will serve as the common entrance for activities for Arena 1 and Arena 2. Direction to each rink will be clearly marked. Please check the Mariners Centre website in advance to learn what activity is in each rink. DO NOT EXIT BACK THROUGH THE LOBBY.

Arena 1 players and spectators will exit through the emergency exit at the end of the changeroom hall. Arrows on the floor are clearly marked to the exit which opens to the front of the building facing the west end of the parking lot.

Arena 2 players and spectators will exit through the door at the north end of the Arena 2.

**DRESSING ROOMS:** Masks must be worn until helmets come on. One person in the washroom at a time. Teams are not to come out of the dressing room until it's time to go on the ice.

**NON-DRESSED PLAYERS:** Non-Dressed Players may sit socially distanced in the stands with the spectators, however once they sit down and leave the Field of Play they are not permitted back into the Field of Play (e.g.; dressing room area) until the end of the game.

**VISITING FANS:** Visiting spectators are encouraged to sit socially distanced in the stands in front of the Visitors Team Bench to encourage some separation within the crowd.
